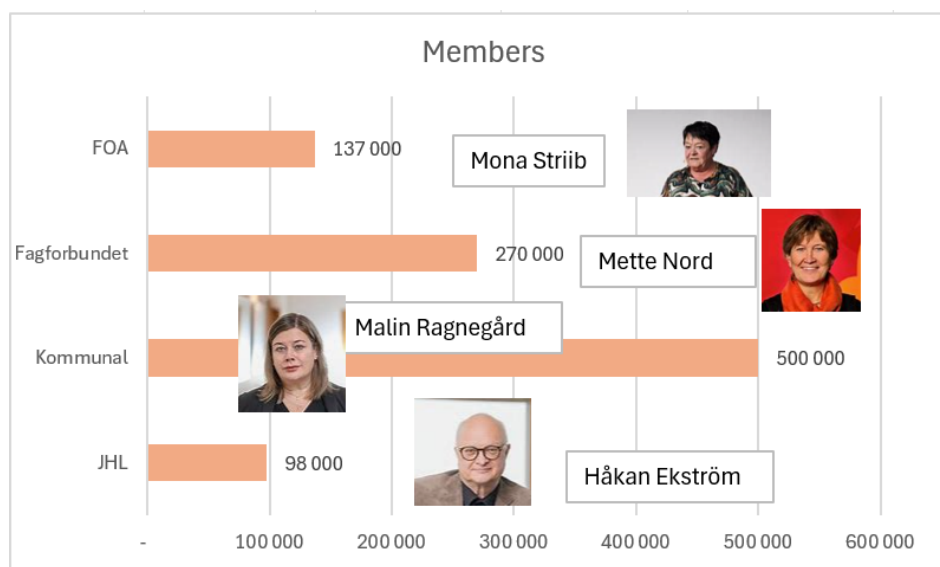
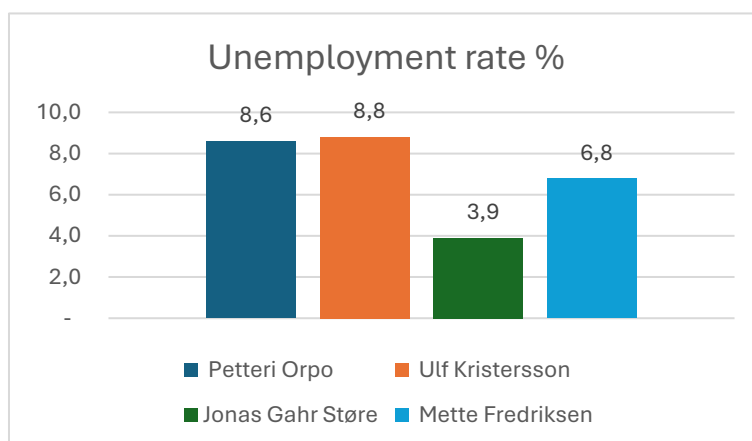

Finland:
Government coalition with a far-right party

Sweden:
Government coalition backed by a far-right party

Norway:
Labour Party minority government

Denmark:
Government coalition led by Labour Party prime minister

Denmark	Dannebrog =the oldest continuously used national flag (year 1219)	the 130th smallest country in the world – out of 195 countries (Greenland not included)
Finland	First European country to give all women the right to vote (year 1906)	3 million saunas (more than cars!?)
Sweden	First country with a law to forbid violence against children. (year 1979)	Approximately 300,000 – 400,000 moose freely roaming in the woods
Norway	Norway's Government Pension Fund Global is the world's largest sovereign wealth fund, valued at \$1.6 trillion as of 2024	Half the world's Sami population live in Northern Norway.
